#### **Outreach Information and Workshops**

Outreach information and workshops are provided (by arrangement) throughout the Hampden and Hampshire Counties to local agencies, including: landlord associations; employment, education and training institutions; social service agencies; municipal and business groups; senior/elderly service agencies; cultural groups/agencies; and the faith-based community. The HCEC counselors and the agency's Fair Housing Coordinator provide workshops on: Housing Search, Tenant Rights and Responsibilities, Eviction Prevention, Fair Housing and Landlord Education.

#### **Housing Search Resources**

Housing search resources are available to assist homeless and atrisk households in their search for safe, sanitary, and affordable housing. Counselors provide housing search and assistance using a variety of tools, including access to: Massachusetts Rental Voucher Program (MRVP) project-based listings, landlord listings, subsidized-housing project lists, and area housing authority lists. The HCEC features a resource room that includes a computer with internet connection, printer, copier, and telephone to assist clients in their search for housing.
